
PLG Singapore started at Changi Airfreight Centre, providing Airfreight services and solutions to customers.

PLG setup Yangon Office in Myanmar and also PLG Manila Office in Philippines.


PLG set up the fifth overseas office in Bangkok, Thailand.

PLG has expanded to 1.4 million sqf with 8 facilities (Changi, 13 Tuas South Link 4, 16 Senoko Way, 202 Pandan Loop, 8 Tuas South Lane, 13 Tuas South Street 6, 10 Tuas South Street 1 and Chin Bee) in Singapore.





On the other hand, PLG has also been awarded GSSA for China Southern Airline for Laos.



PLG has plans to expand and open Vietnam office next year.

OUR FACILITY

PLG acquired license premise located at Tuas South. We store imported non-dutiable goods for a prolonged period of time with the Goods and Service Tax suspended. Our company provides storage spaces at our Zero GST warehouse for our customers where cargoes are pending for transit.

PLG is currently storing high-valued vehicles for our customers and high conductivity metal for electronics.

Our facilities are equipped with 3 tiers security to ensure cargo are safely stored. We also impose safety and security measures on our employees as well as the installation of surveillance camera surrounding our warehouse premises.



PROJECTS

PLG has a team of dedicated professional providing lashing service with over 15 years of experience. The aim for lashing is to secure the cargo for transportation with minimal movement. PLG's customer, FLS has engaged our company to assist with the lashing of their Police Patrol Craft onto a flat rack container for exportation.

The Speed Boat has a height of 3.2m, length of 12.5m, width of 3.2m and total tonnage of 6 ton, which is considered an over width and over height cargo which requires police escort. We are also able to provide arrangement of police escort to PSA port for our customer.

PLG is a proud partner of YUXINOU's remarkable achievement

YUXINOU, a reputable train operator in China marks a total breakthrough of 10,000 inbound and outbound trains since the opening of China-Europe (Central Asia) trains at Khorgos railway port in December 2012.





YUXINOU trains are loaded with 41 TEUs of daily necessities, auto parts and other goods, weighing more than 800 tons and items-worth amounting to about 60 million yuan. We have seen an increase of 32% in train frequency to Central Europe (Central Asia) line.

The outbound trains mainly transported "Made in China" items such as clothing, products and building materials to Eurasian countries; the return trains mainly transport imported goods such as iron ore, timber and auto parts from Eurasian countries to Chongqing and other Chinese cities.
